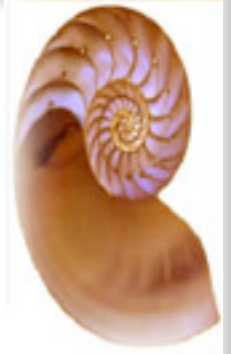


# Applied Mathematics Prize

- Eternal fame, through being added to the official, public, list of winners.
