A basket with six eggs

You're trying to fit spherical Easter eggs into a single layer in a basket with a square base. To save costs, you want to use as small a basket as possible while still fitting the eggs in its base.

If each egg has a diameter of two inches, what is the smallest side-length of a basket which can hold three eggs? What about for four eggs? Can you generalize this to five, six, or *N* eggs?
